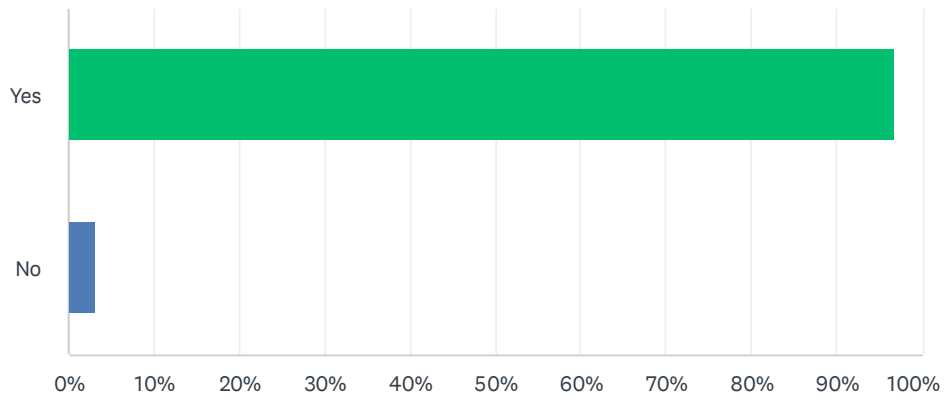


Q1 Do you live in San Anselmo?

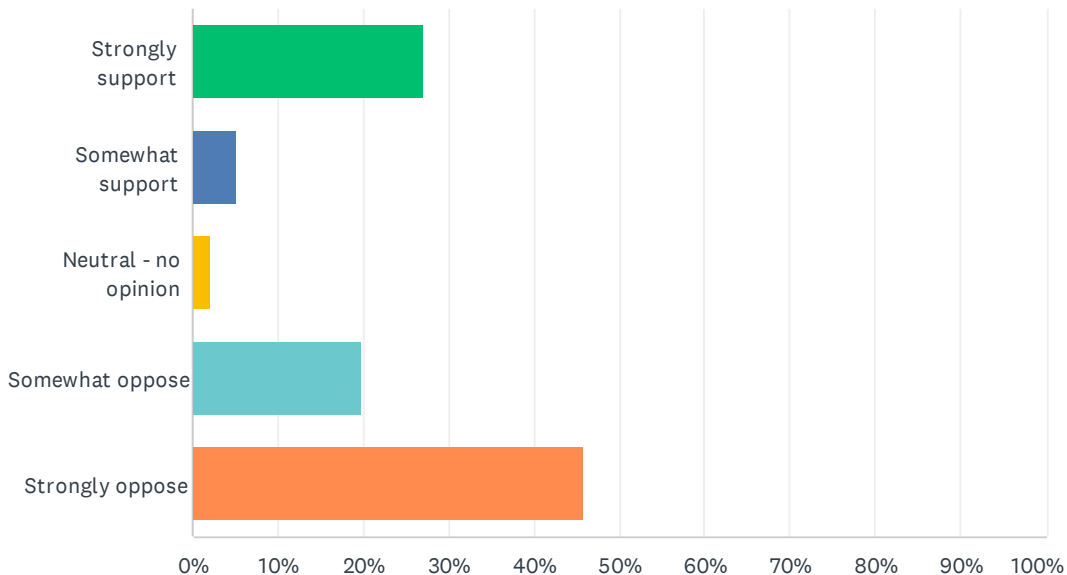

Q2 Would you support or oppose a proposed all-electric construction requirement for newly constructed residential buildings?

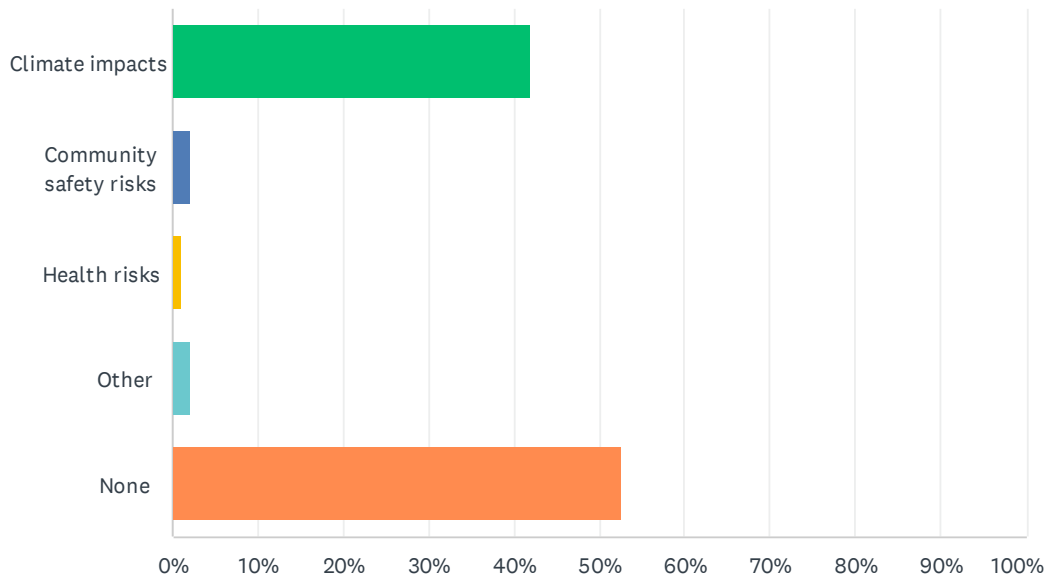

Q3 What aspects of gas appliance use concern you?

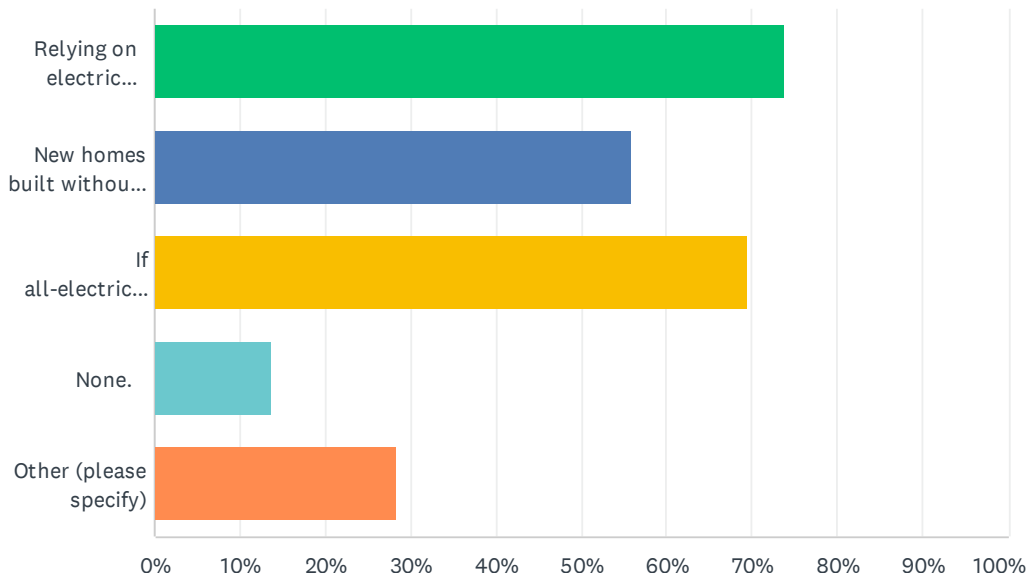

Q4 Do you have concerns with a proposed requirement for all-electric appliances in newly constructed residential buildings? Check all that apply:

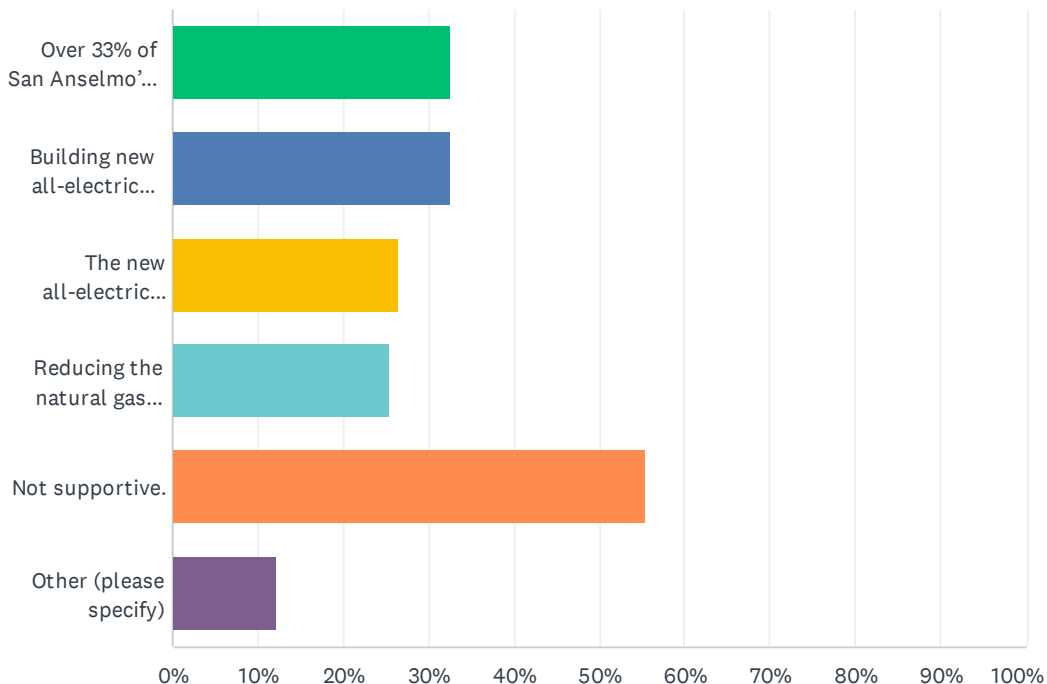

Q5 If supportive, what reasons do you see for supporting all-electric construction in newly constructed residential buildings? Check all that apply:

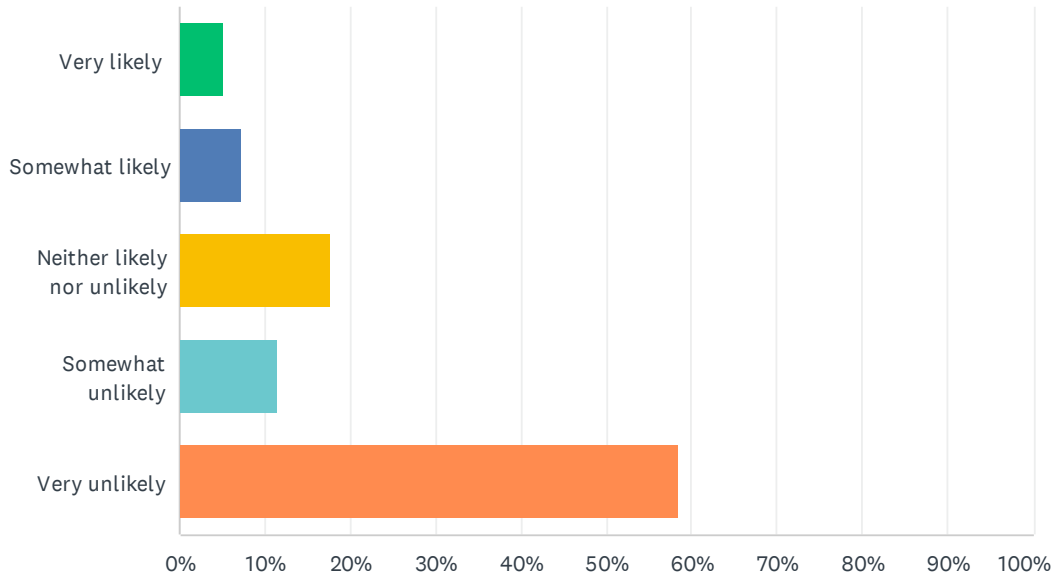

Q6 How likely are you to build a new home in San Anselmo in the next 5 years?

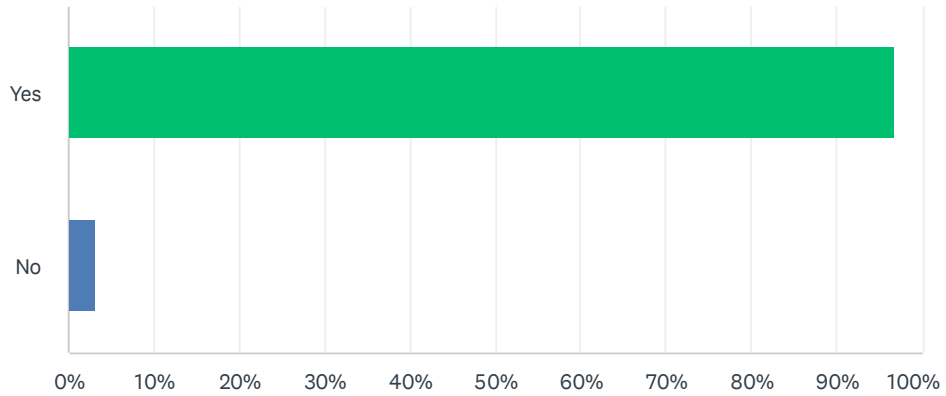

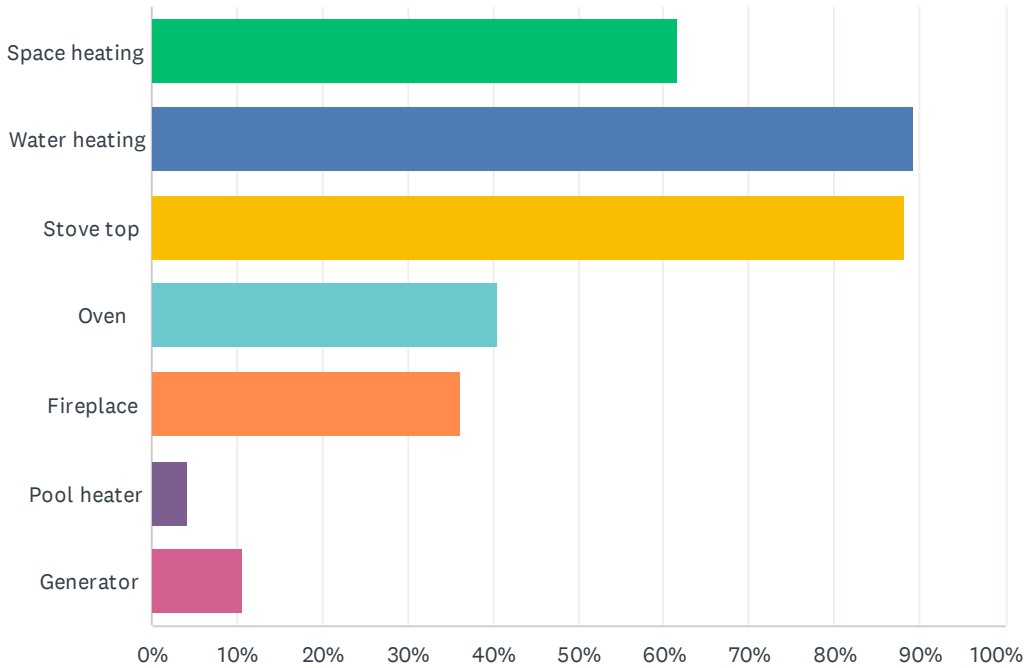
