What are your qualifications for this appointment.*

No single individual reflects the diversity, interests, and needs of the Town of San Anselmo. Nonetheless, I am confident that my professional background, previous experience on the Planning Commission and passion for San Anselmo would contribute greatly to our Town and the Planning Commission.

Benefits I bring to the Planning Commission follow:

A demonstrated commitment to community service as evidence by my volunteer participation and 22-year residence in San Anselmo.

Strong interpersonal and independent decision-making skills along with a willingness to learn and share. Planning and design experience gained from attending graduate architecture school at UC Berkeley. This experience is complemented by a comprehensive understanding of land use policies.

Having a 25-year professional career in marketing and business development for notable Bay Area architecture, engineering, and construction firms. This includes current involvement in industry associations, Urban Land Institute and Commercial Real Estate Women.

Understanding the importance of protecting the public's interest and ethical behavior.

Briefly, what do you consider to be the most important, one or two current issues facing this Board/Commission/Committee?*

There are several current issues of concern in San Anselmo. These include Land use and planning, fire prevention, homelessness, traffic, and flood protection, to name a few. I believe addressing the lack of housing is one of the most important issues our Town faces.

The Association of Bay Area Government's (ABAG) Regional Housing Needs Assessment has shed light on the lack of affordable housing and set specific goals to address the issue around the Bay Area; this includes cities and towns in Marin County.

Many commercial properties suffer from long-term vacancy, are obsolete, and not generating revenue for property owners. Converting existing structures into housing could be an attractive option for investors. Potential solutions could include making amendments to the Town general plan to allow for adaptive reuse of commercial space and / or rezoning commercial districts to create development of housing. For example, the Bank of America (BoA) could become a highly desirable, mixed-use transit-oriented project. Currently, there is a small commercial building on Pine Street for sale just behind the BoA building, which is about 4700 rental square foot property. It could easily be converted into a 2–4-unit residential property with modifications making it meet code since it's in the flood zone.

I also believe that reinvigorating our downtown commercial is essential not only for our community but to shore up and increase our town finances.

I understand that I and all other applicants will be personally interviewed by the Town Council as part of the selection process for this appointment.
